

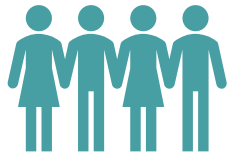

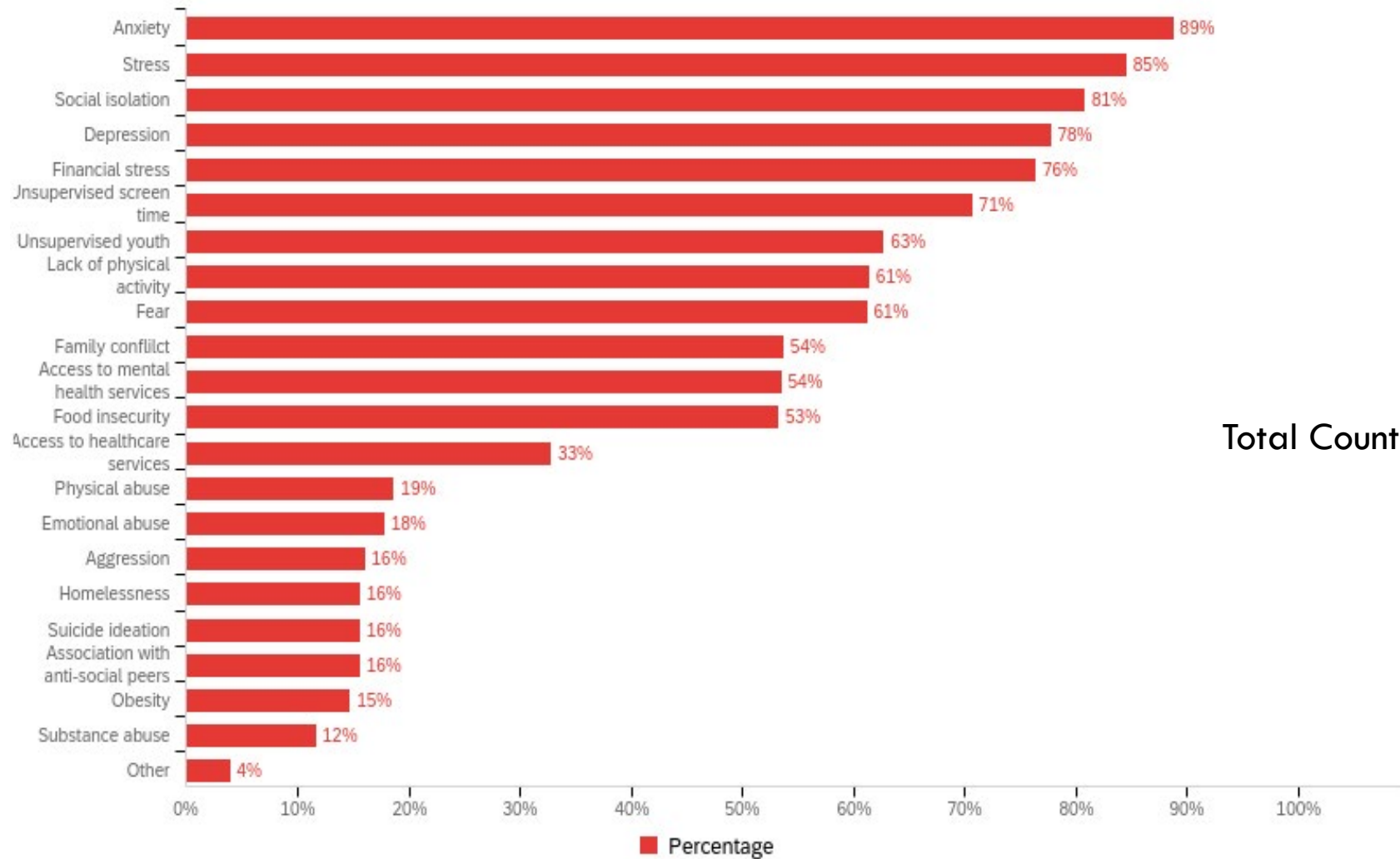
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Based on your observations, what risk factors have increased as a result of the COVID-19 Pandemic? (select all that apply)

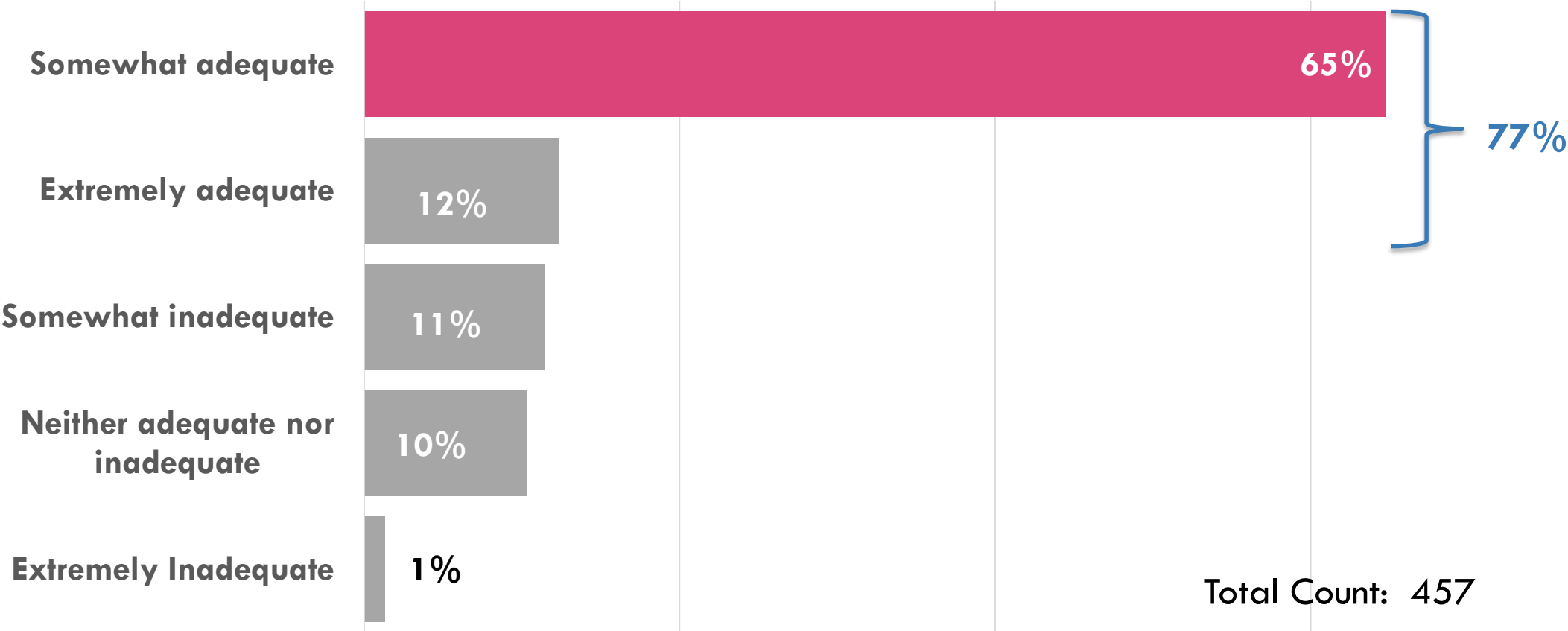


Increased Risk Factors from COVID-19: Top 6 Responses



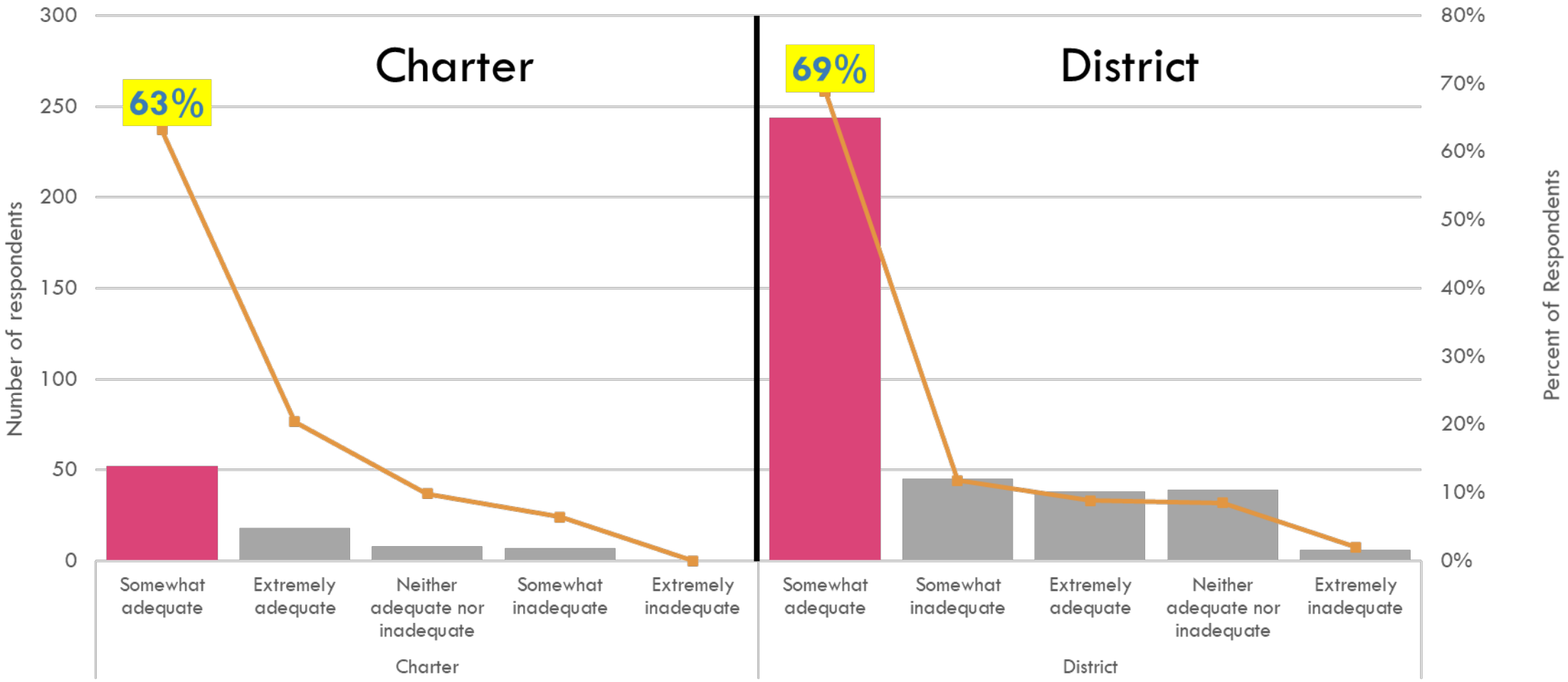
How adequately prepared do you feel your school is in providing services to students following the COVID-19 Pandemic?

Somewhat to extremely adequate make up **77%** of respondents



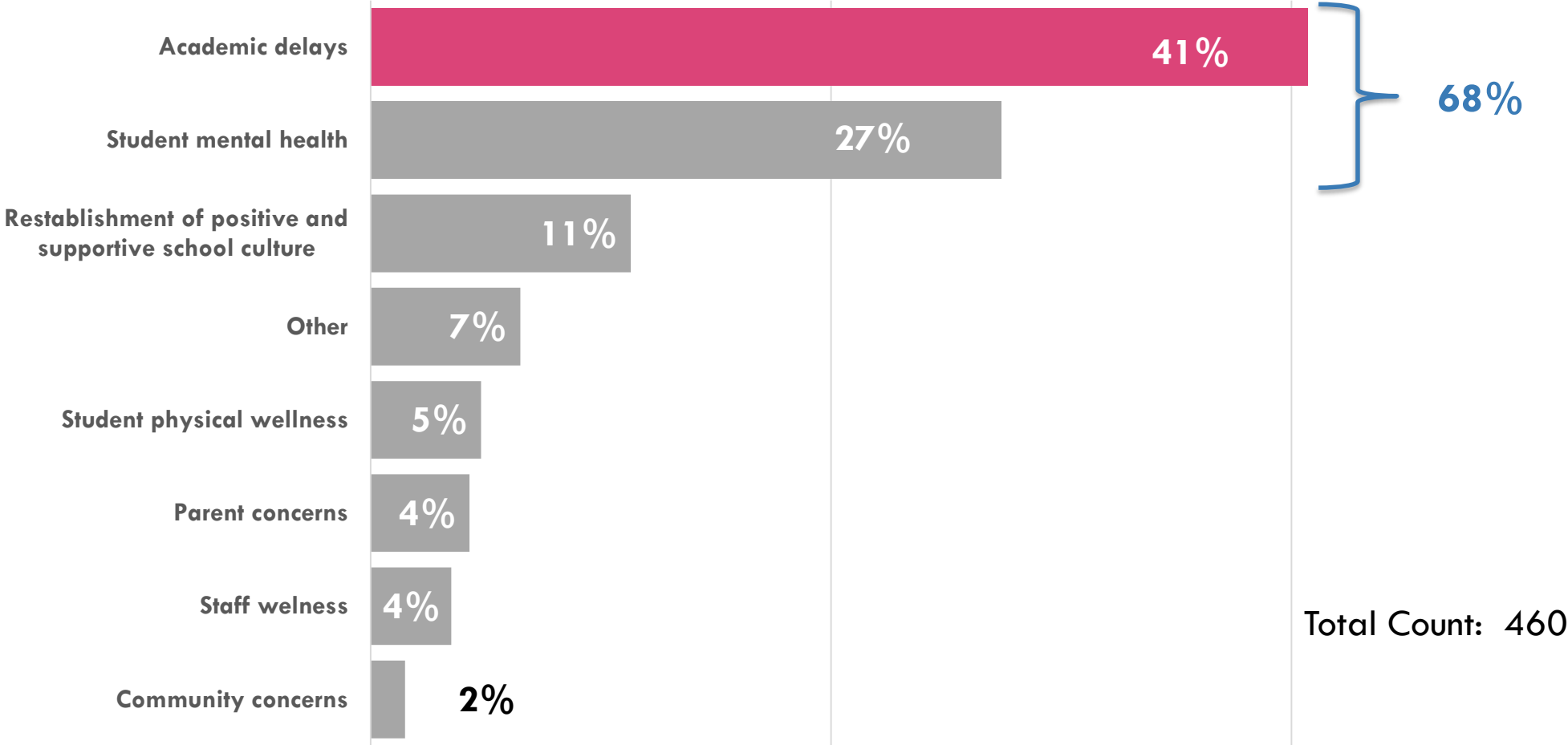
How adequately prepared Cont'd:

“Somewhat Adequate” >60% for Charters and Districts

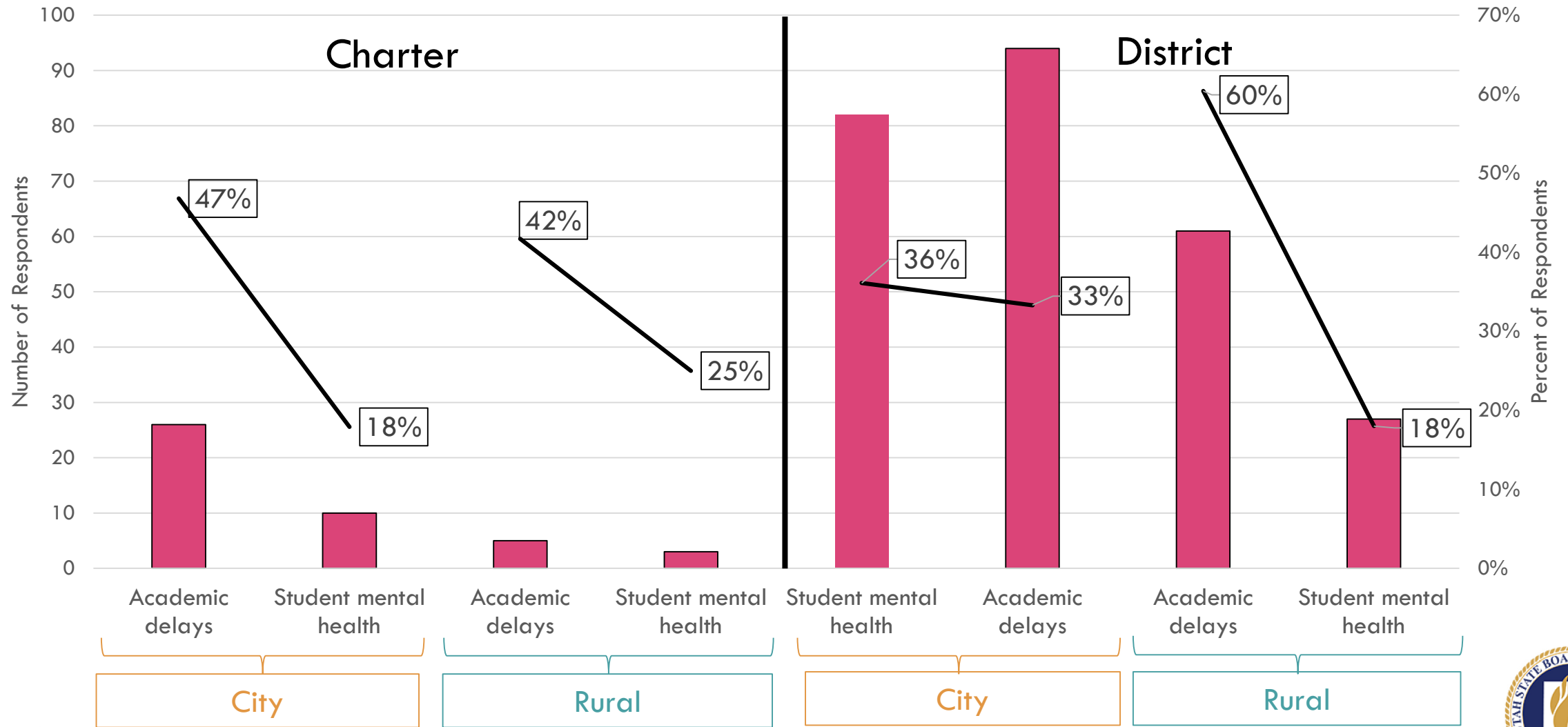


Select your area of greatest concern regarding student reentry following the COVID-19 Pandemic?

Academic Delays + Student Mental Health > 2/3 of all concerns

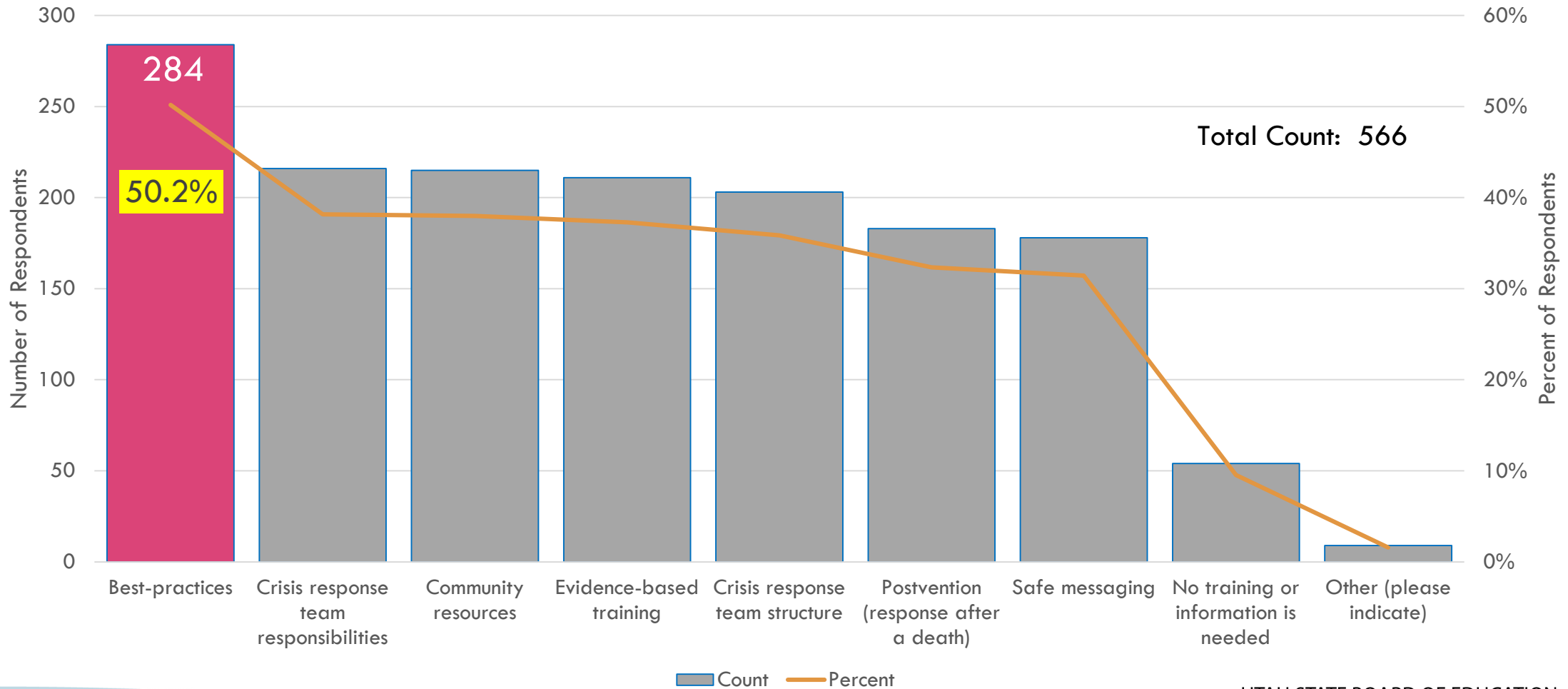


Academic Delays and Student Mental Health are Top Concerns across state

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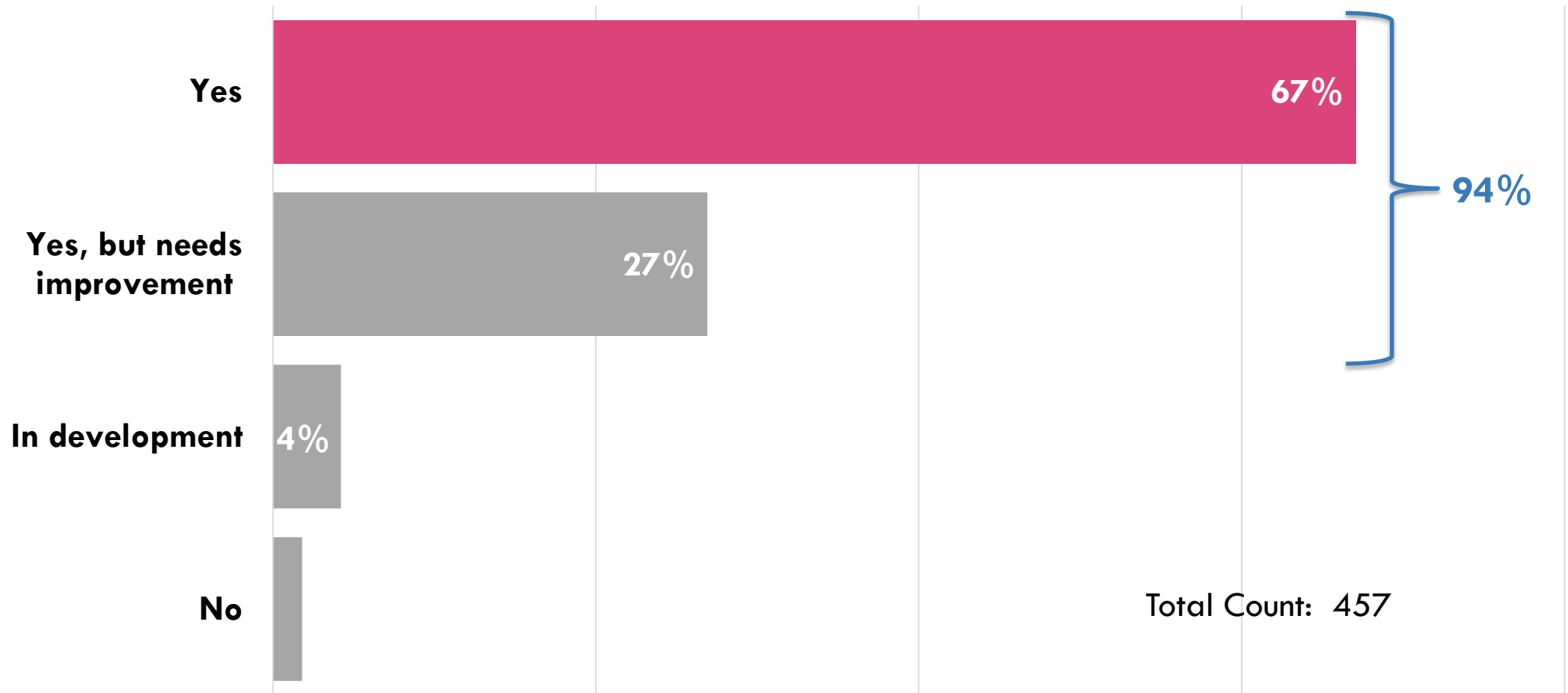
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My school uses a multi-disciplinary team to discuss supports and interventions for students who are struggling (i.e. risk behaviors, mental health problems, social and emotional development).

94% using multi-disciplinary team for students struggling

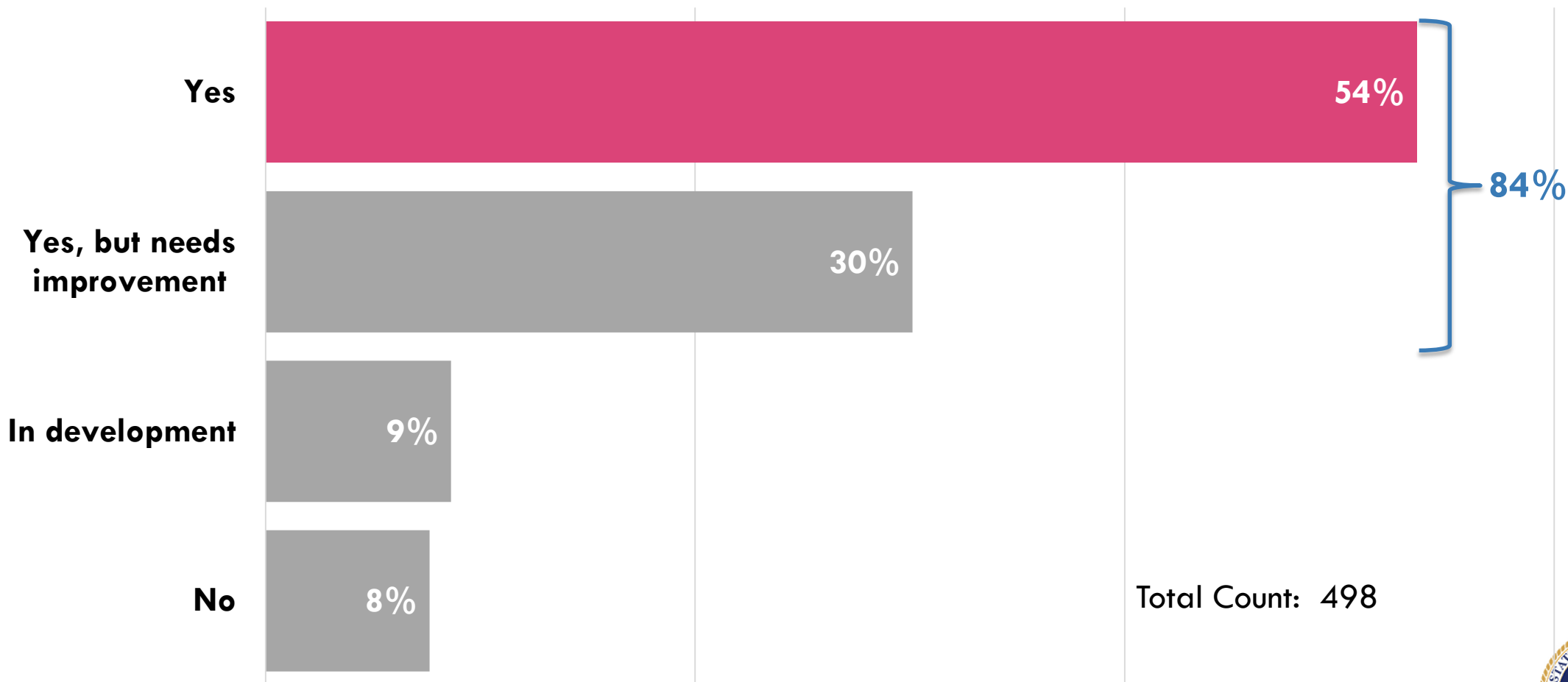

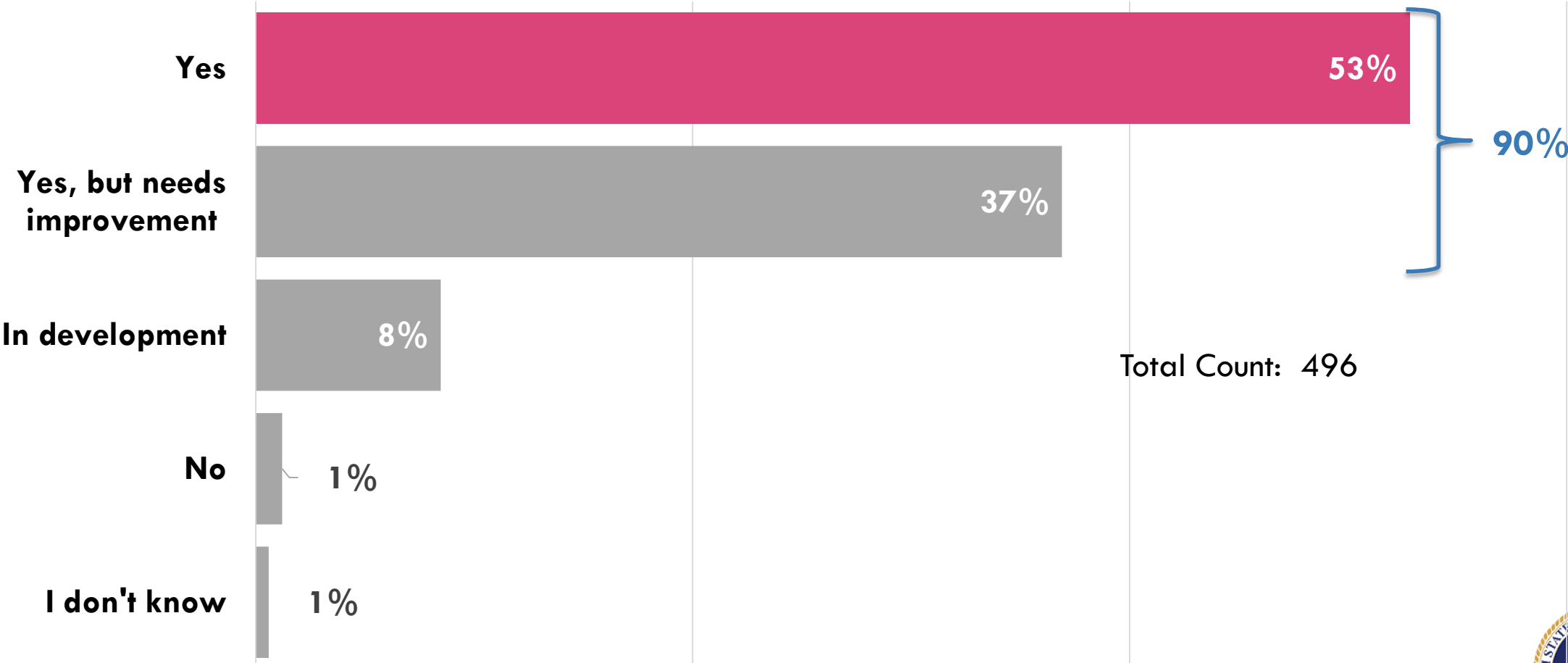
My school uses a multi-disciplinary team (that is not implemented solely for student IEPs or 504s) to identify, assess, and intervene with possible threats at the school.

90% using MTSS to implement interventions based on student's need(s)



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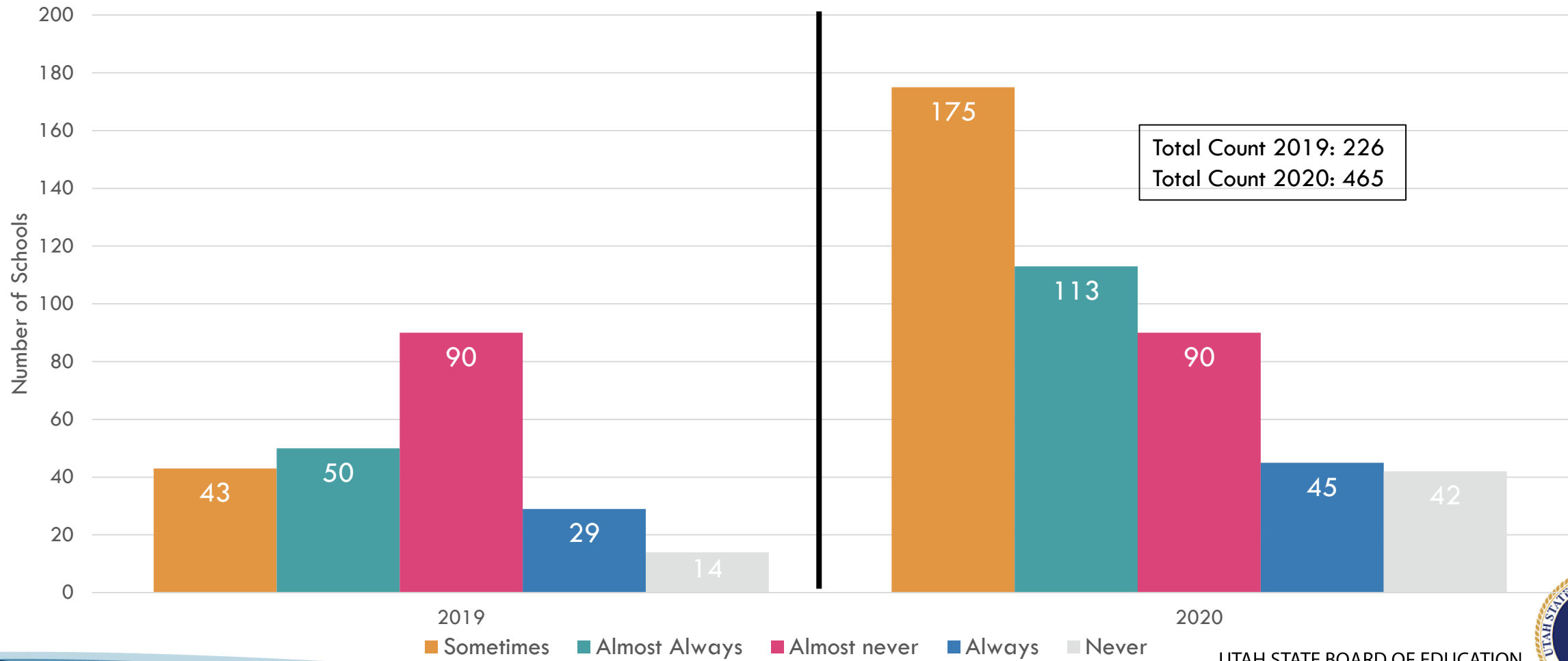
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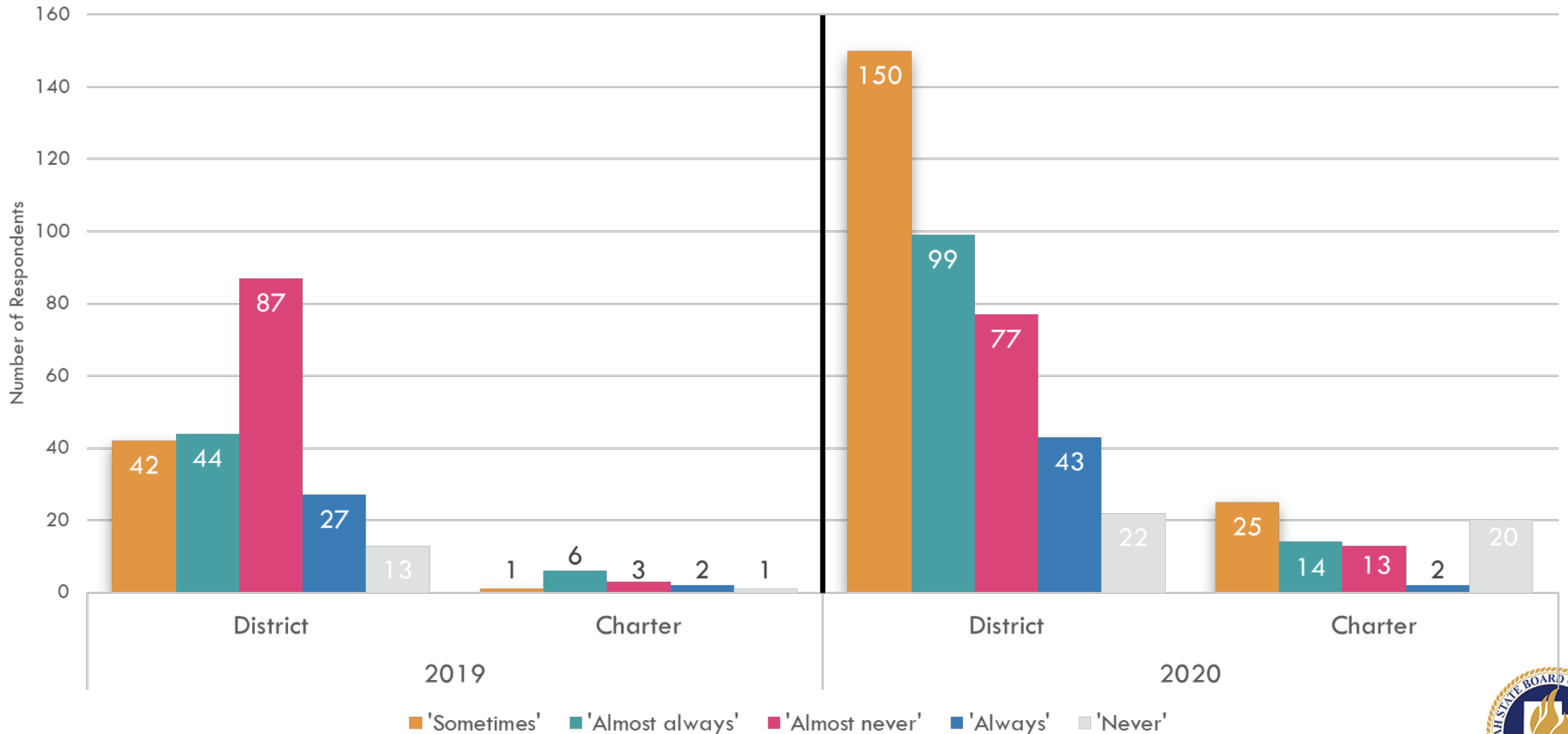
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The SRO, or another law enforcement officer, is involved in the resolution of school safety incidents.

Collaboration with law enforcement has been showing an increase

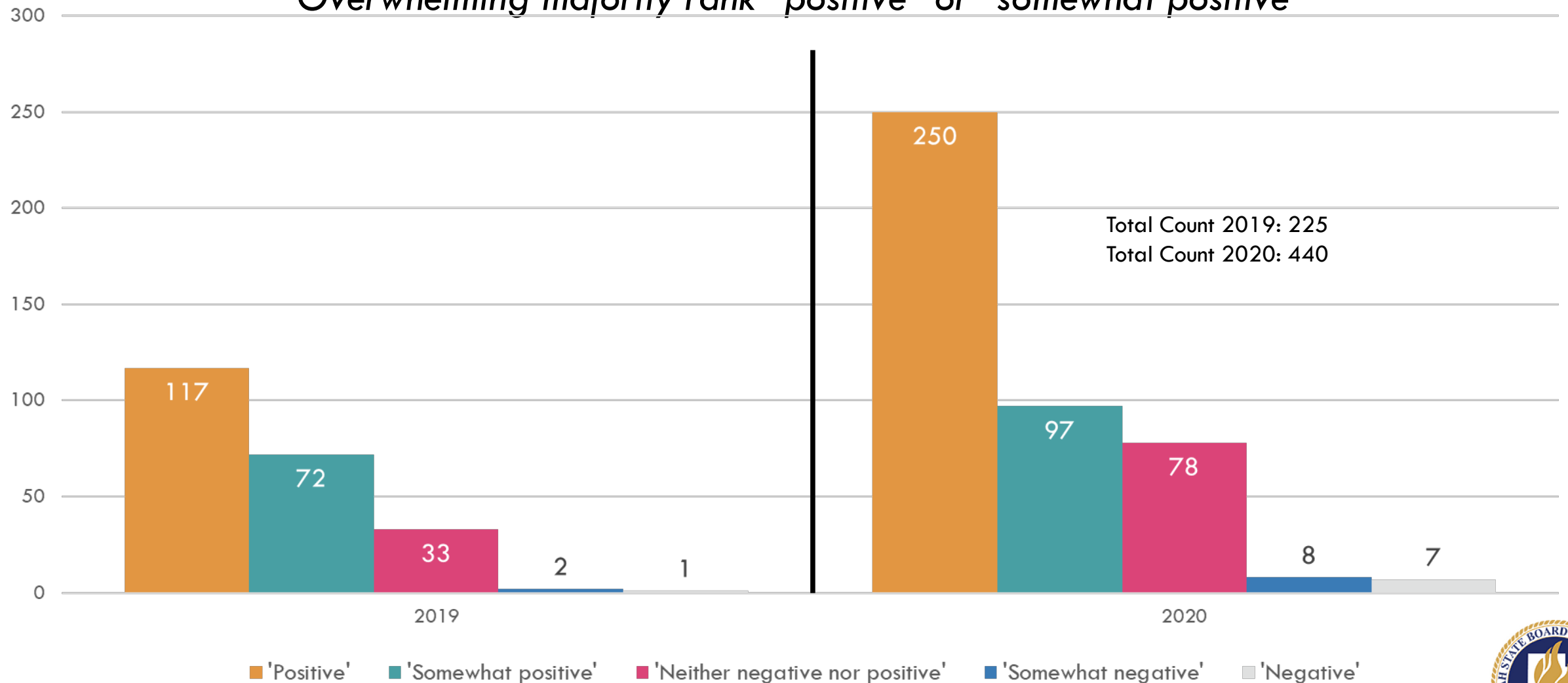


Collaboration is happening more frequently in districts and charter schools

Overwhelming majority rank “positive” or “somewhat positive”



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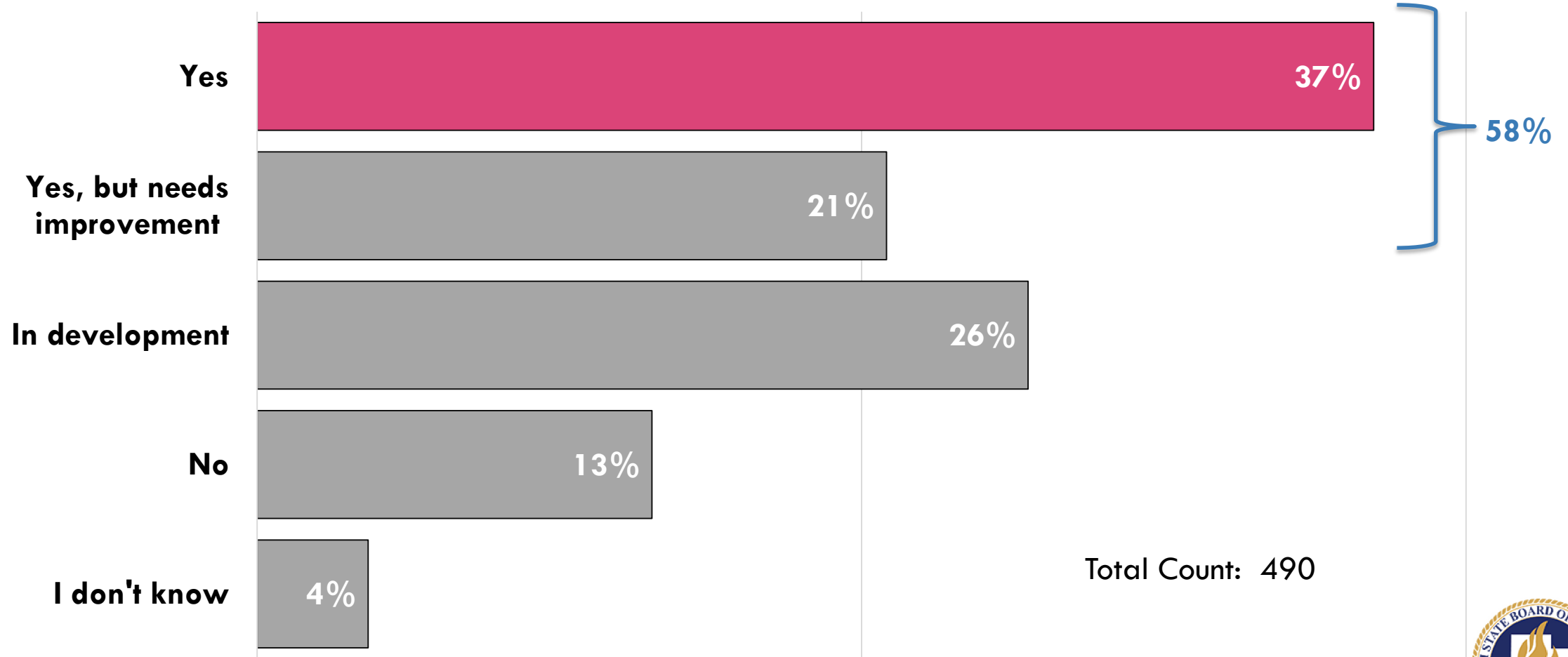
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Are you using a Social and Emotional Learning (SEL) curriculum in your school?
